Retired N.F.L. running back Chuck Muncie leads the charge for US Privacy Associates after being named the companies liaison to professional sports athletes.

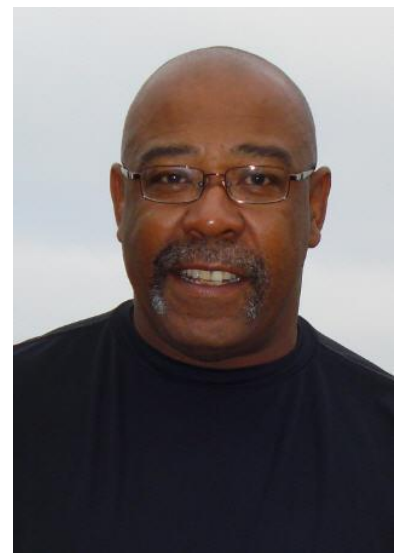
